**Cross-border philanthropy in Europe.** FAIB Lunch- Debate of 12.01.2012

**Ludwig Forrest**, advisor at the King Baudouin Foundation ([www.kbs-frb.be](http://www.kbs-frb.be)) presented the Foundation and focused on tax-deductible gifts to non-profit associations. While figures show a growing trend, the KBF is involved throughout the whole process since 10 years as a member of the Transnational Europe Giving Network (15 countries and a subsidiary in the USA). Actions launched by the EU DG Taxation and Customs Union helped to create a momentum. Ludwig Forrest broadened his presentation on the procedure to follow in order to receive fiscal exemption and to benefit of donations channeled by the KBF.

**The European Transparency Initiative (ETI).** FAIB Lunch Debate 16.02.2012 by Mr Gérard Legris, Head of Unit “Transparency and coordinator of the common Parliament - Commission Transparency Register Secretariat;

The speaker gave an outlook of the experience gained since 2008. The number of 5000 organizations recorded will be soon reached. The Common register EP – EC enhanced the transparency of the system. It worked as a preliminary step for a fast-track access to the Parliament's buildings. Linked to art.11 of the Lisbon Treaty, the ETI could involve the Council of Ministers in a near future. Complementary guidelines will be published with a purpose of clarification and harmonization. In the meantime, the Secretariat proceeds with sample screening of the registrations. The review of the system will prompt a public consultation in May 2012.

In the debate, FAIB members were anxious to discuss the impact on the application of the Belgian VAT, the voluntary character of the register, the definitions used for the various categories of operators and the use of the ETI as an anti-corruption tool.

**Récentes évolutions du droit du licenciement individuel** Déjeuner-débat du 15.03.2012 par Me Olivier Debray, membre associé FAIB, avocat associé au Cabinet Claeys & Engels.

Cette branche du droit, «polluée» notamment par la discrimination ouvriers / employés vient de connaître une première évolution avant un bouleversement attendu pour la mi-2013. Le législateur a établi 3 catégories d'employés et applique un traitement différencié aux employés dits «supérieurs» au travail depuis le 1.1.2012 en matière de négociation et de fixation du préavis de rupture. Me Debray a aussi expliqué l'application de la «grille Claeys». Il a donné divers conseils pratiques bien utiles pour la rédaction du contrat de travail, du règlement de travail et sur les procédures de licenciement.
